



FISHING RULES

Our caravan and camping patrons may fish the river (the River Irfon) that runs alongside the park free of charge, so long as they comply with these rules:

1. Fishing times are **dawn to dusk** (night fishing is not allowed)
2. Anglers aged 13 & older should have in their possession a valid **Environment Agency (EA) rod licence** (free for 13-16-year-olds but must be obtained before fishing.)
3. Use **one rod** only at a time & **never leave a rod unattended** with its hook in the water!
4. Artificial wet or dry **fly fishing** is available from **1st April to 31st October** (target species Grayling only, after 30th September).
5. **Float fishing using natural earthworm** is available from **16th June to 30th September** inclusive. *(a) Hookbaits other than natural earthworm and groundbaits are not allowed' (b) all weights above dust shot size must be lead free; and (c) any other bait fishing method, or spinning, are not allowed.* All artificial fly or bait hooks must be **barbless**.
6. **All fish must be returned to the river unharmed.** *(a) other than for minnows & par fish should be netted and not beached; (b) landing nets must have knotless mesh; and (c) keepnets are not allowed.*
7. **Select a spot away from others** who are fishing or otherwise enjoying the river. *Other patrons may be sitting along the riverside, dipping, or paddling etc – you must give way to others – fishing is only permitted if space is available.*
8. **Be careful with your casting!** *Fly fishing backcasts can be very dangerous so please ensure your cast is not near other people, or their caravan, tent, picnic space etc.*
9. **Please look after our fish!** *Fish will be harmed if you handle them with dry hands, wrap them in a rag during unhooking, or place them on the ground. This is because fish have a protective slime on their scales: if this becomes damaged, fungal infection normally results.*

Fishing (following the rules above) is allowed in the adjoining field by kind permission of our neighbour, but here you must have a PERMIT

You can buy a permit from Reception. £10 per day, or £50 per season.

These rules are designed to comply with relevant law & help all our patrons to have a safe & enjoyable stay!
